



# Lampasas ISD Admission Information

I the parent, guardian, or other person with legal control of the child acknowledge that I am responsible for completing all district registration forms, including online Family Access updates, and providing the district with all required documentation at the time of enrollment.

*TEC 25.002: When accepting a child for enrollment, the school district shall inform the parent or other person enrolling the child that presenting a false document or false records under this section is an offense under Section 37.10, Penal Code, and that enrollment of the child under false documents subjects the person to liability for tuition or costs under Section 25.001(h).*

Upon enrollment, a parent, guardian, or other person with legal control of a child shall present or provide the district with:

1. The student's birth certificate or other acceptable document as listed in the Student Attendance Accounting Handbook. The person enrolling a student that is under 11 years of age will have 30 days from enrollment, or up to 90 days from enrollment for a child not born in the United States, to provide a certified copy of the child's birth certificate.
2. The student's social security card.
3. The student's complete immunization records required by TEC §38.001, proof that the student is exempt from immunization, or proof that the student is eligible for provisional admission pending the receipt of immunization records.
4. Acceptable proof of residency in the guardian's name that shows the address where the student lives. Proof of Residency includes a current electric, water, cable, or other bill showing that services are provided to that property; or a notarized, dated "Verification of Address From Property Owner" affidavit with whom the student lives along with acceptable documentation.
  - *Lampasas ISD may send a school representative to the listed residence on any given date and at any given time to verify the residence of the enrolling student. The district may withdraw the student if they are determined not to be living at the listed residence.*
5. A copy of student's records from the mostly recently attended school. These records include the withdrawal form, transcript, final report card, or other educational records.
6. The parent's/guardian's photo ID. Examples include but are not limited to a state issued driver's license, passport, or government-issued ID.
7. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to provide the school with any court order or changes to a court order that pertain to the parent-child relationship.

*TEC 25.002: If the information required by Texas Education Code 25.002(a) is not furnished to the district within the period provided by that subsection, the district shall notify the police department of the municipality or sheriff's department of the county in which the district is located and request a determination of whether the child has been reported as missing.*
